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## Stamp Sets

- Rooted In Nature (148217) *Retired*

## Ink, Markers, & Other Colouring Options

- Mossy Meadow Ink Pad (147111)

## Accessories

- Adhesives: Dimensionals (104430); Mini Glue Dots (103683); Stampin' Seal (152813)
- Mossy Meadow 3/16" Braided Linen Trim (154298)
- Hippo & Friends Dies (153585)
- Scalloped Contours Dies (155560)
- Gold Glitter Enamel Dots (152155) *Retired*

## Measurements:

- Mossy Meadow Card Base: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4" on the long side
- Basic White: 3-3/4" x 2-1/4" for 2<sup>nd</sup> card for label/greeting
- Fine Art Floral DSP: 4" wide and 5-1/4" long (note some panels on this 12x12" sheet has open white space and some do not.
- Golden Garden Acetate DSP: 4" wide and 5-1/4" long - matching the panel that you cut from the Fine Art Floral DSP. You know ... it's just easier to cut the whole sheet of Fine Art DSP and acetate and make 6 cards at once. That way, you can match the gold accent to the DSP very easily!
- Mossy Meadow Trim: 11"

## Instructions:

1. Using the largest rectangle die from the Scalloped Contours dies, cut out the 4"x5-1/4" piece of Fine Art Floral DSP.
2. Take the matching piece of Golden Garden Acetate and trim 1/8" from all 4 sides. Note: if you just trim off 1/4" on the top and one side, the gold accent will not match up!
3. If you are using a piece of the DSP that has white space in the top left area, just stamp your greeting with the Mossy Meadow ink directly to the DSP (see LEFT card for sample).
4. If you have a piece of DSP that is completely covered with the floral design, stamp your greeting on the small piece of Basic White card stock and cut out using the medium sized oval die that has squared-off corners (see picture on RIGHT).
5. Lay the coordinating Golden Garden Acetate over the DSP and, using several Mini Glue Dots, adhere the acetate to the DSP in places that are not as likely to show. For the card on the left, Mini Glue Dots were placed under the Gold Glitter Enamel Dots and a few spots under the flower.
6. Thread one end of the Mossy Meadow trim down into the scallop opening 6 scallops from the bottom right corner. Bring this end up through the 6<sup>th</sup> scallop from the bottom left corner. Make a square knot in the center of the card and trim off any excess.
7. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the DSP panel and adhere to the card base.
8. Add your personalized greeting to the inside of the card; stamp an envelope as desired and give to someone special in your life. Everybody needs a little love in their mailbox!
