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Stamp Sets

- Special Moments Stamp Set SAB Jan/Feb 2022 (158081)

Ink, Markers, & Other Colouring Options

- Calypso Coral Ink Pad (147101)
- Soft Suede Ink Pad (147115)

Cardstock, Designer Series Paper, etc.

- Calypso Coral Cardstock (122925)
- Very Vanilla Cardstock (101650)

Accessories

- Butterflies & Flowers Layering Decorative Masks (158142)
- Blending Brushes (153611)
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)
- Wink of Stella Clear Glitter Brush (141897)
- Polished Dots (158134)
- Low-tack painters tape

Measurements:

- Calypso Coral Cardstock: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4 along the long side
- Very Vanilla Cardstock: 4" x 5-1/2", 4" x 5-1/4"

Instructions:

1. Place the large open butterfly mask at an angle near the center of the 4" x 5-1/2" piece of Very Vanilla cardstock. Adhere to your workspace with the low-tack painters tape.
2. Place the group of flowers mask over the open butterfly mask and secure with painters tape.
3. Using a Blending Brush, load with Calypso Coral ink and use firm pressure to the layered masks in a circular pattern. Reload with ink until floral pattern is quite dark. Remove the floral pattern mask only and, using the remaining ink on the Blending Brush, swirl ink into the butterfly opening of the mask. Keep the ink lighter than the floral pattern.
4. Repeat with another partial butterfly above and below the central butterfly, using other mask patterns as desired.
5. Using the greeting of your choice, stamp using Soft Suede ink onto the lower right area of the card front.

6. Use Multipurpose Liquid Glue to adhere the card front to the front of the Calypso Coral card base.
7. Outline the center butterfly image with Wink of Stella and add 3 or 5 pink coloured Polished Dots as desired.
8. Use the individual flower masks to add flower(s) to the Very Vanilla layer for the inside of the card. Add stenciled images to the envelope flap (achieve the ombre look by applying more ink to the left side of the flap than the right).
9. Add your personalized greeting and enjoy giving your card to someone special.
