- White 3/8" Glittered Organdy Ribbon (156408) carryover from 2021 June to Dec 2021 mini catalogue
- Holiday Rhinestone Basic Jewels (150457)
- Wink of Stella Clear Glitter Brush (141897)
- Mini Cut & Emboss Machine (150673)

Measurements:

- Misty Moonlight Cardstock: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4 along the long side
- Balmy Blue Cardstock: scrap approximately 2" x 2"
- Thick Basic White Cardstock: 3-1/2" x 5-1/4", 4" x 5-1/4" for inside layer
- Simply Marbleous DSP: (Misty Moonlight/Balmy Blue pattern) 2" x 5-1/2" plus 6" x 2-1/2" for the envelope flap if desired
- White 3/8" Glittered Organdy Ribbon: 8"

Instructions:

1. Use the approx 2-3/4" wide scalloped rectangle die to cut the 3-1/2" x 5-1/4" piece of Thick Basic White cardstock.
2. Stamp the large camellia flower in the center of the scalloped rectangle die cut using Misty Moonlight ink (you can use the Stamparatus if you'd like).

INK AND SPARKLE STAMPING

- Stamp the “You’re in my Thoughts today” greeting on the scrap of Balmy Blue cardstock. Use a 1-1/2” circle die or punch to punch out the circle.
- Using the dark Balmy Blue Blends Marker, swipe the brush tip across the top surface of the 3/8” Glittered Organdy Ribbon.
- Add Stampin’ Seal generously to the back of the 1-1/2” Balmy Blue circle and loop the coloured ribbon (see picture if desired).
- Add Multipurpose Liquid Glue to the back of the 2” x 5-1/2” piece of the Misty Moonlight/Balmy Blue swirled pattern Simply Marbleous DSP and adhere to the Misty Moonlight card base so that the left edge of the DSP is approx. 1/4” from the left edge.
- Use Multipurpose Liquid Glue to add the scalloped rectangle stamped layer to the front of the card so that the top left edge is tilted a bit towards the left (see picture if desired).
- Add 4 Stampin’ Dimensionals to the back of the Balmy Blue circle/ribbon layer and adhere near the bottom right edge of the scalloped rectangle stamped layer.
- Use Wink of Stella to add shimmer to the flower images.
- Add 5 light blue Holiday Rhinestone Basic Jewels to the Thick Basic White scalloped rectangle layer.
- Stamp desired images/greetings to the remaining 4” x 5-1/4” piece of Thick Basic White cardstock and adhere on the inside of the card.
- Add your personalized greeting to the inside of the card and send or give to someone special.

Here is another option for the envelope flap so that it matches your card: It uses a 2” x 6” piece of the matching DSP, glued to the envelope flap so that the top edge is approx. 1/4” from the top of the flap. Then add a 1/4” x 6” strip of Balmy Blue cardstock to the top edge of the flap. Normally we would cut a 2-1/4” x 6” piece of DSP for the flap but in order to make ore use of the DSP, cut at 2” and use Balmy Blue cardstock to make up the rest of the measurement! Enjoy!
