Stamp Sets

Calming Camellia Stamp Set (158117)

Ink, Markers, & Other Colouring Options

- o Crumb Cake Ink Pad (147116)
- Soft Suede Ink Pad (147115)

Cardstock, Designer Series Paper, etc.

- Crumb Cake Cardstock (120953)
- Linen Specialty Paper (155681)

Accessories

- Stampin' Seal (152813); Mini Glue Dots (103683)
- Very Vanilla Scalloped Lace Trim (149593)
- Gold Fine Art Ribbon (154561)
- White Stampin' Chalk Marker (132133)

Measurements:

Crumb Cake Cardstock: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4 along the long side

Linen Specialty Paper: 3-1/2" x 4-3/4"

o Gold Fine Art Ribbon: 3-1/4"

Very Vanilla Scalloped Lace: 3-1/4"

Instructions:

- **1.** Use Crumb Cake ink and repeated stamp the large flower image randomly along all edges of the Crumb Cake card front. Clean and dry stamp.
- 2. Add Linen Specialty Paper layer to the Stamparatus if using and place clean floral stamp slightly above center. Close the acrylic Stamparatus plate in order to pick up the cling side of the stamp onto the plate itself. Add Soft Suede ink to the stamp and stamp directly onto the Linen Specialty Paper. Repeat if necessary. If not using the Stamparatus, add ink generously to the stamp and firmly stamp onto the Linen Specialty Paper layer.
- **3.** Stamp the greeting using Soft Suede ink positioning the greeting with enough room to add the ribbon layers.
- **4.** Use Mini Glue Dots to the top of the Very Vanilla Scalloped Lace piece and lay the piece of Gold Fine Art Ribbon on top. Use additional Mini Glue Dots to adhere the ribbon layers just above the stamped greeting.
- **5.** Use the White Stampin' Chalk Marker to add white colour to the flower petals and use the Garden Green Watercolor pencil to add colour to the leaves.
- **6.** Stamp the leaf image on the inside of the card and add your personalized greeting. Stamp additional images on your envelope front and/or back. Give or mail to someone special in your life.
