## Measurements:

- Crumb Cake Cardstock: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4 plus scrap for cutting board
- Pacific Point Cardstock: 3-1/2" square
- Daffodil Deligh Cardstock: 4-3/4" x 3-1/2" plus scrap for whisk
- Basic Black Cardstock: scrap to diecut flipper
- Basic White Cardstock: 3" x 1-1/2" for greeting label
- B&W Check from DSP: 3-1/2 square

## Instructions:

1. Diecut all pieces: rounded rectangle label from Basic White, cutting board from Crumb Cake, flipped from Basic Black, whisk from Daffodil Delight and 2<sup>nd</sup> largest circle from Layering Circles dies from Pacific Point cardstock.

## INK AND SPARKLE STAMPING

2. Use Pacific Point ink to stamp “What’s cookin’?” somewhat closer to the right edge of the label.
3. Add the Black & White check square to the center of the Daffodil Delight cardstock and then adhere the Pacific Point circle so that approx. 1/4” overhangs the left edge of the B&W Check/Daffodil Delight layer. Turn the cardstock over and trim off the excess approx. 1/4” of Pacific Point cardstock.
4. Add the Daffodil Delight layer to the front of the card using Stampin’ Dimensionals.
5. Add the Crumb Cake cutting board diecut to the Pacific Point circle at an angle (see picture).
6. Add one Stampin’ Dimensional to the back of the Basic White label so that the dimensionals are at the right and left edges of the label shape only. Add a small amount of Stampin’ Seal or Liquid Multipurpose Glue to the center of the back of the lable and adhere near the bottom of the Crumb Cake cutting board.
7. Roll several glue dots between your fingers and use to adhere the flipper and whisk to the left side of the Basic White label (see picture for placement).
8. Add 3 Rhinestone Waves Basic Jewels (I used the 2<sup>nd</sup> darkest colour of blue rhinestones).
9. Stamp the inside of the card as desired and add a strip of additional Black & White checked DSP near the bottom of the inside of the card.
10. Add your personalized greeting and enjoy sending or giving the card to someone special.
