Measurements:

- Smoky Slate Card Stock: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4 along the long side
- Basic White Card Stock: scrap approximately 2-1/2" x 4-1/4"
- Coastal Cabana Card Stock: scrap approximately 3" x 4-1/4"
- Basic Black Card Stock: scrap approx 1-1/2" square
- Silver Foil Sheet: 1-1/2" square

Instructions:

1. Using a Blending Brush, swipe firmly across the Pear Pizzaz ink pad. Tap off gently on a scrap piece of paper. Using a swirling motion, add ink to the lower center area of the card base,
2. Repeat Step 1 using Pool Party ink and place the swirls of ink above the Pear Pizzaz ink.
3. Add 3 tree images to the center of the card base using the solid image of the large evergreen tree, Stamp off once on a scrap piece of paper and stamp the solid image and repeat x 3.
4. Stamp the large coordinating evergreen tree image on top of the 3 trees you stamped in Step 3 using Shaded Spruce ink (full strength).
5. Stamp the dog image with Early Espresso close to one corner of the scrap of Basic White. Leave room for the trailer die cut in Step 6.

6. Die cut the dog image and the trailer from the scrap of Basic White card stock.
7. Die cut the hitch stand from the Silver Foil (hitch stand is what my husband says we call the support “thingy” at the front of the trailer!!).
8. Die cut a trailer tire from the Basic Black card stock.
9. Use Multipurpose Liquid Glue to add the Coastal Cabana accent pieces to the Basic White trailer die cut. Use Multipurpose Liquid Glue to add the Silver Foil hinge stand to the trailer as well.
10. Add Stampin’ Dimensionals to the back of the trailer and add to the card front, slightly to the right of center.
11. Stamp the dog paw prints to the left under the trailer (note in my card: the paw prints are facing away from the dog ... you can make them the right way!)
12. Add Mini Stampin’ Dimensionals to the back of the dog and add to the card front.
13. Add 4 opaque and 1 clear gant Faceted Gems above the evergreen trees.
14. Stamp the Happy Birthday greeting to the right lower area of the card front using Early Espresso ink.
